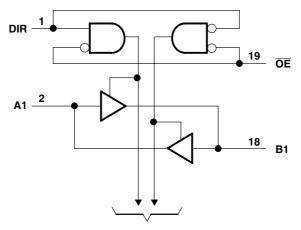

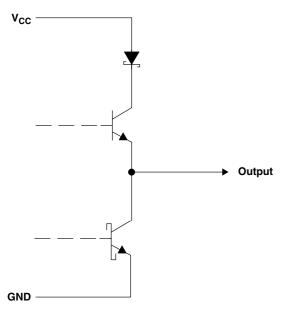

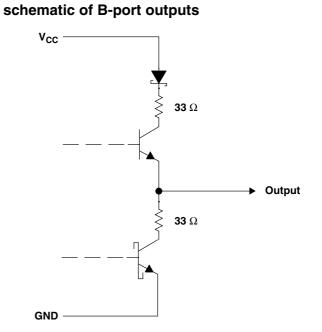
### logic diagram (positive logic)

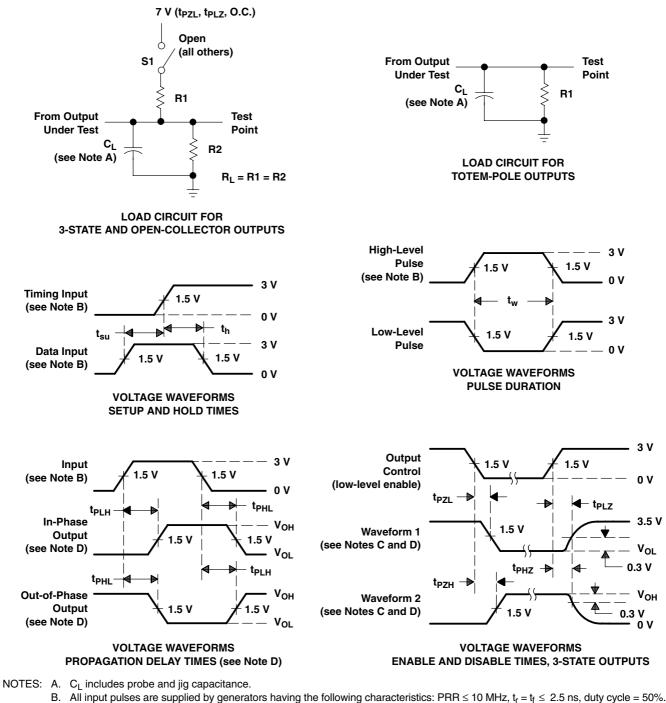
