




Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage






**On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature**


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
### **THERMAL RATINGS** ( $T_A = 25 \text{ °C}$ , unless otherwise noted)





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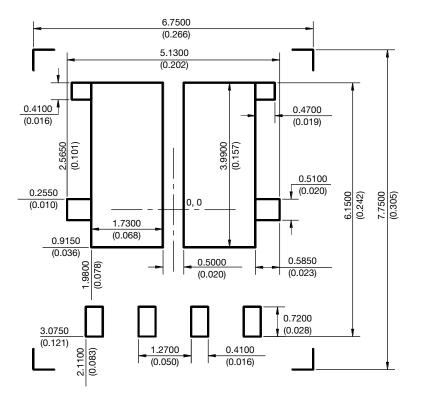
